The Professional Women in Building Council is interested in furthering the educational opportunities for women in the construction field. We believe that the scholarship assists in encouraging women to consider the construction field as a career and overall goal of the Builders Association of the Twin Cities.

Students who submit a completed scholarship application and who meet the Council's requirements will be considered for this scholarship.
